

Health Guarantee Agreement

Please read the following agreement very carefully. If you have any questions, please ask for clarification.

To the best of my knowledge, this puppy is in good health at time of delivery. Buyer has 3 working days to have the puppy checked by a licensed veterinarian. Failing to do so will **VOID** the *Cooper's Canine's Health Guarantee Agreement*. If your licensed veterinarian discovers the puppy to be unsound, puppy can be returned to breeder(s) along with a letter from your licensed veterinarian stating why the puppy is unsound. This letter will then be taken to breeder(s) personal licensed veterinarian to be confirmed. If breeder(s) personal veterinarian does in fact confirm and agree that the puppy is unsound, puppy will be replaced with a puppy of equal or greater value at the breeder(s) discretion. There will, however, be **NO** replacement after the previously stated 3 business day period.

Breeder(s) will **NOT** replace or refund for any reason, including but not limited to, allergy, mortality, landlord's disapproval, family disagreement, or any other problems not related to health. Furthermore, breeder(s) will **NOT** replace or refund for any reason, including but not limited to a puppy illness caused by neglect, exposure to weather, injury, choking, poisoning, etc. No warranty or guaranty is made to the disposition, life span, size, color, show quality, or breeding quality of any puppy. Breeder(s) is selling puppy as a companion only, and there is no guaranty on breeding of said puppy. If puppy is bred before 1 year old by accident or deliberate intent this health guaranty/warranty of puppy is **VOID**. Breeder(s) will **NOT** be liable for any expenses, including but not limited to, any veterinarian bills or other expenses once puppy leaves breeder(s) facility. Should a licensed veterinarian diagnose said puppy with a life-threatening birth defect, or genetic defect, the breeder(s) will replace puppy, limited to 1 year from date of purchase. Breeder(s) must be provided with a letter from a licensed veterinarian detailing the life-threatening problem.

NO refund will be made on deceased puppy until a necropsy is performed to determine the cause of death. An accredited institution that is capable of such procedures, such as, Texas A & M University, must perform the necropsy procedure. A necropsy procedure performed by a local veterinarian **WILL NOT** be accepted.

The owner(s) of said puppy is responsible for **ALL** expenses and understands breeder(s) will not be held liable for any expenses. The necropsy report must accompany any request for replacement or refund. **NO** guaranty of **ANY** kind is given for worms, coccidiosis, or giardia. These parasites are too common to puppies and can be contracted from water, soil, or buyer(s) facility.

Buyer(s) understand that said puppy has been wormed at 2, 4, and 6 weeks old for 5 consecutive days each time. It is the responsibility of the buyer(s) to continue in worming said puppy frequently. It is imperative that said puppy be placed on monthly heart worm preventative (required). Internal flea preventatives that contain pesticides such as *Sentinel* and *Comfortis* are not acceptable and will **VOID** your guaranty. *Frontline*, *Advantage*, or *Revolution* are recommended for flea prevention. **NO** guaranty is given for Hypoglycemia (low blood sugar). This condition **IS NOT** hereditary and is preventable. This guaranty **IS NOT** transferable.

Please be conscientious about vaccinating your puppy properly. Over vaccination can cause long-term effects and could possibly be fatal. Vaccination related deaths **ARE NOT** covered under the *Cooper's Canine's Health Guarantee Agreement*. Moreover, please refrain from allowing puppy to be placed on any grounds until the said puppy has received all their vaccinations. Please note, puppies that have not been fully vaccinated prior to being placed on the ground are extremely susceptible to *Parvo*.

Please Note:

- It is the sole responsibility of the buyer(s) to bring said puppy to a licensed veterinarian within three business days of purchase.
- Once the appointment is made, be sure to bring puppies shot record to veterinarian.
- Upon arrival, be sure to ask veterinarian for a fecal check. This will allow the veterinarian to check for worms.
- REMEMBER: Do **NOT** place puppy on ground until it is **FULLY** vaccinated.
